
I have completed my review of the application of MAVIS, also known as 2257ware. I reviewed the version 1.2 demo sent to me via zip file, the flash marketing version, and also referred to the FAQ section found at <http://www.2257ware.com>.

My evaluation was to determine if the software would provide the necessary data to an investigator conducting a 18 USC 2257 compliance check. From the evaluation, I determined that the software allows an investigator to search by model name, model last name, production title, URL, or identifying number as required by the regulations associated with 18 USC 2257. The software also must allow storage of digital images or reference to storage location.

It is my opinion that the MAVIS software meets all the record-keeping requirements of the 2257 regulations, as effective June 23, 2005. The software meets or exceeds all requirements necessary for an investigator to conduct a thorough and comprehensive 2257 compliance examination.
